

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTGOMERY, INDIANA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN AND NAMED HIGHWAYS AND ESTABLISHING PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SPEED LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Article I - Definitions:

(a) Words and phrases, when used in this Ordinance, shall have the same meanings as are described in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code as amended.

(b) The word "highway" shall be used interchangeably with the word "street" and shall have the same meaning as the word "street" as defined in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

(c) The singular shall include the plural and the plural shall include the singular.

Article II - Enforcement:

The police officers of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, including any police officers covered by a cooperation agreement shall have the authority to enforce this Ordinance.

Article III - Traffic Regulations:

The maximum speed limits are hereby established on portions of certain highways as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of any of these highways where a maximum speed limit is applied at a greater speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the highway:

<u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>PORTION BETWEEN</u>	<u>MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT</u>
Gorman Road Township Route 687	Legislative Route 1051 and Gorman Summit Road	25 MPH

Bowdertown Road Legislative Route 1031 and 35 MPH
Township Route 851 Legislative Route 1028

King Road Legislative Route 1032 and 35 MPH
Township Route 946 Township Route 851

Article IV - Penalties:

Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before a District Justice or otherwise be sentenced to pay a fine and costs as set forth in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code for violations of maximum speeds.

Article V - Severability:

Provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and if any provisions shall be held unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.


Article VI - Effective:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage, however, it may not be enforced until passed.
