

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTGOMERY, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE THE INCREASE OF SUPERVISOR COMPENSATION FOR ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED and it is hereby ordained by the Township Supervisors of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. That each Supervisor of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, elected or appointed to office on or after November 3, 1987, shall receive compensation in the amount of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) for each meeting that said Supervisor attends.
2. This compensation shall be paid on a monthly basis.
3. In no event shall any Supervisor of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, receive an excess of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) per year in compensation for attendance at meetings.
4. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1988.
5. All prior ordinances dealing with compensation that conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby invalid and rescinded to the extent that they conflict with this ordinance.
6. In all other respects, all other ordinances of Montgomery Township dealing with compensation or benefits for Supervisors shall remain in full force and effect.
