ORDINANCE ACCEPTANCE OF CERTAIN STREETS OF ARCADIA AS TOWNSHIP ROADS

WHEREAS, the owners of property abutting upon the hereinafter described streets which are designated on a map to be attached hereto have joined in a written request that the same be accepted as township roads, releasing all claims to damages and waiving notice of hearings thereon, and at a hearing on May 7, 1959, the Supervisors decided in favor of exercising the power to accept the same as township roads.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that there be opened as township roads of the Township of Montgomery, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, certain streets in the Village of Arcadia designated in the map hereto attached, a description of said streets being:

BEING parts of Kerr Avenue and of Fifth Avenue as shown in the Plan of Lots of the Arcadia Land Company of August 8, 1904 recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Indiana County in Deed Book B 83, page 428 and beginning at the intersection of Kerr Avenue and First Avenue in said Plan, First Avenue now being State Highway Route 80 and continuing eastwardly along the course of Kerr Avenue to Fifth Avenue and thence northwardly along Fifth Avenue to Clark Avenue which is now a part of State Highway Route No. 360.

The right of way for township road to have a width of 40 feet, and approximate length of 900 feet (700 feet, more or less, being on Kerr Avenue and 200 feet, more or less, being on Fifth Avenue) and the approximate area covered by the said right of way amounting to a total of .8 acre, more or less.
