REPORT OF SUPERVISORS

The Supervisors of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, make the following report:

1 It came to the attention of the Supervisors of Montgomery Township that a portion of Township Road No 689 which is a dirt road that has not been used or maintained for a number of years remains as a Township Road; said portion of Township Road No 689 being described as follows:

Running from Township Road No 936
 a northwesterly direction, a distance
 of 850 feet.

2 The Supervisors instituted proceedings for the vacation of said portion of Township Road No 689 pursuant to the provisions of the Second Class Township Code, as amended, (53 P.S. Section 19093-1102). August 17, 1956, at 1:00 o'clock P.M. D.S.T. in the offices of Fisher, Ruddock & Simpson, Attorneys for the Township, in Indiana, Pennsylvania, was fixed as the time and place for a hearing thereon and written notice thereof was given on August 3, 1956, to the property owners affected thereby as is evidenced by written acknowledgment of acceptance of notice hereto attached.

3 The hearing was held at 1:00 o'clock P.M. D.S.T. in the offices of Fisher, Ruddock & Simpson, Attorneys for Montgomery Township, in the Savings & Trust Company Building, at Indiana, Pennsylvania. It was attended by two of the Supervisors, Jack R. Henry and Delmont Allison; the third Supervisor, Harry W. Gardner, being unable to attend the hearing by reason of a death in his family.

It was expressed as the opinion of all present, as well as of Harry W. Gardner and of the abutting land owners, that the abandonment of this portion of Township Road No 689 is desirable and advisable.

4 At said hearing the following matters were established:

- a Width of Road: The actual roadway is overgrown and it is believed that the right-of-way is of a width of thirty-three feet.
- b Length of Road: The length of the portion of road to be vacated is approximately 850 feet.
- c Improvements: There are no improvements along said road; the abutting land is woodland and pasture land, and, in fact, there are two fences across the road.
- d Abutting Owners: Said road runs through lands owned by Anthony P. Tate and lands owned by Marsh Hamilton.
- e Course of Road: The said Township Road No 689 runs in a northwesterly direction from Township Road No 936.

5 It was also developed at the said hearing that said road has not been used or maintained for a number of years and that it is the desire of Anthony P. Tate and Marsh Hamilton, who own all the land on both sides of said road, that the road be vacated as a Township Road. The Supervisors, after due consideration, determined that the road should be vacated.

6 The meeting was thereupon adjourned so that this report could be prepared in duplicate and filed in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Indiana County with the intention that thereafter a resolution vacating said road would be adopted by the Supervisors of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania.
