#### REPORT OF SUPERVISORS

The Supervisors of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, make the following report:

1. It came to the attention of the Supervisors of Montgomery Township that a portion of Township Road No. 928 which was a dirt road that has not been used or maintained for a number of years remains as a township road; said portion of Township Road No. 928 being described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on State Highway No. 262, commonly known as Route 80, a short distance to the West of the Village of Hillsdale; thence in a northerly direction a distance of 168 feet, more or less, to its terminus at State Highway No. 32084, being the black top road from East Run and Marion Center to the Village of Hillsdale.

~~The Supervisors instituted proceedings under the~~  
provisions of the Second Class Township Code, as amended, (53 P.S. Section 19093-1102). January 21, 1956 at 10:00 o'clock A.M. in the office of Fisher, Ruddock & Simpson, attorneys for the Township, in Indiana, Pennsylvania, was fixed as the time and place for a hearing thereon and written notice thereof was given on December 31, 1955 to the property owners affected thereby as is evidenced by written acknowledgment of acceptance of notice hereto attached.

3. The hearing was held at 10:00 o'clock A. M., in the offices of Fisher, Ruddock & Simpson, Attorneys for Montgomery Township, in the Savings & Trust Company Building at Indiana, Pennsylvania. It was attended by the three Supervisors: Jack R. Henry, Harry W. Gardner and Delmont Allison, and by Clair D. Gromley, who, with his wife, owns all land abutting on said portion of the road. It was expressed as the opinion of all present that the abandonment of this portion of Township road No 928 is desirable and advisable.

4. At said hearing the following matters were established:

- (a) WIDTH OF ROAD. The vacated road bed was less than 24 feet wide but it was assumed that the exact width of the right of way was probably 33 feet.
- (b) LENGTH OF ROAD. The length of the portion of road to be vacated is approximately 168 feet.
- (c) IMPROVEMENTS. There are no improvements along the said road.
- (d) ABUTTING OWNERS. Said road runs through a parcel of land owned by Clair Gromley and June Gromley, his wife.
- (e) COURSE OF ROAD. It appears that said road runs in a northerly direction curving a bit to the East, a draft of the road being hereto attached.

5. It was also developed at the said hearing that said road has not been used or maintained for a number of years and that it is the desire of Clair Gromley and June Gromley, his wife, who own all of the land on both sides of said road, that the road be vacated as a township road. The Supervisors, after due consideration, determined that the road should be vacated.

6. The meeting was thereupon adjourned so that this report could be prepared in duplicate and filed in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Indiana County with the intention that thereafter a resolution vacating said road would be adopted by the Supervisors of Montgomery Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania.
