Primary Election Polling Place: Kevin motioned to sign the form stating that the Township Polling Place Facility is open to use on June 02, 2020, second Ed, carried. Ed will call and speak to them about having mail in voting due to the size of the building it would be impossible to keep a 6" distance

Extend 2% Discount on Taxes: The Indiana County Commissioners asked if the township would consider extending the 2% discount on the Spring Taxes due to the pandemic. Bill

motioned that if the County decides to extend the 2% discount on taxes that the township would be in favor of doing that here in our township, Second Kevin, carried.

Police Report: The report was emailed to the Secretary. Hours worked 26 at \$30.00 an Hour for a total of \$780.00. Officer Berkin was exposed to Covid-19 and is in quarantine for 14 days.
